

City of Chico Million Watt Challenge

The City of Chico Sustainability Task Force, North Valley Energy Watch, Chico Chamber of Commerce, and Chico News & Review are challenging the community to save one million watts (or more!) in 2017. August Energy Conservation and Recycling Tips

The Summer heat is here, and you're worried about the power bills. Try these 8 tips to cool down without reaching for the thermostat.

- Keep your blinds closed. Up to 30% of unwanted heat comes in through windows!
- 2. Set your ceiling fans to rotate counterclockwise.
- 3. **Turn on your bathroom fans...**And your kitchen vents as well, to pull the hot air up and out of your house and vent it to the outside.
- 4. **Let the night air in.** Take advantage of the cool night temperatures and open the windows at night to create a breeze. But be sure to seal up the windows before the morning warms up.
- 5. **Ditch the incandescent lights.** And opt for LED. Incandescent bulbs waste about 90 percent of their energy in the heat they emit!
- 6. **Start grilling.** When the heat is here, don't use the oven or the stovetop. Opt for a toaster oven, or grill outdoors!
- 7. **Make a few long-term improvements.** Insulated window films, for example, are a smart purchase as they work similarly to blinds. And additions like awnings and planted trees or vines on or in front of light-facing windows will shield your home from the sun's rays, reduce the amount of heat your home absorbs and make your investment well worth it!
- 8. **Take an inventory of your home's envelope.** If your home heats up rapidly in the summer, it may need better insulation. You can check out an energy saving DIY Kit from BEC and use the thermal infrared thermometer to determine where your home is leaking heat through the insulation. 
